- (2) Typist's home keys asdf jkl; are ㅁㄴㅇㄹ ㅓㅏㅣ; home keys extended asdfg hjkl; are ㅁㄴㅇㄹㅎ ㅗㅓㅏㅣ;'
  Keep fingers on the home keys and think or feel without looking for the other letters.
- (3) The top row only is case sensitive: the consonants ロスロコム go to their reinforced partners 田田スはコル, the diphthongs 引引 to their moistened partners 引 :
  日田ス双 ロロココ スル (ュ ココ 大川 引) (the reinforced consonants are also given by repeating: ローロール, etc.).
